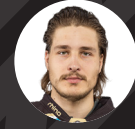
MAN OF THE MATCH

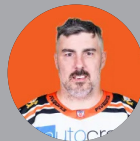
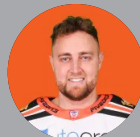
NOTABLE PLAYERS

Bradley Day provided stability in the net for the Telford Tigers during the 2023/24 season, finishing with a .901 save percentage and a 3.54 GAA over 50 games. His playoff performance was marked by resilience, posting a .886 save percentage across 7 games. Day's experience and consistency make him a reliable last line of defense for the Tigers as they head into the 2024/25 season, where his veteran presence will be crucial in goal.



Harry Ferguson returned to British ice in the 2023/24 season with the Telford Tigers after spending time in the EHL. He quickly established himself as a reliable forward, contributing 34 points (15 goals, 19 assists) in 48 games in the NIHL. His playoff performance added 3 points in 7 games, showcasing his ability to perform under pressure. Known for his versatility and two-way play, Ferguson is expected to be a key player for the Tigers in the 2024/25 season, bringing experience and depth to their forward lines.

Vladimír Luka continued to prove his value as an elite scorer in the NIHL during the 2023/24 season with the Telford Tigers. He racked up an impressive 90 points (52 goals, 38 assists) in 53 games, underlining his offensive prowess. Luka's consistent scoring was vital to the Tigers' success, although his playoff performance was quieter with 4 points in 7 games. With his vast experience and scoring touch, Luka remains a key offensive threat for Telford as they look to build on last season's achievements.
