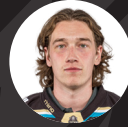
MAN OF THE MATCH

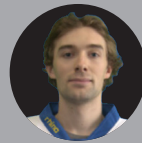

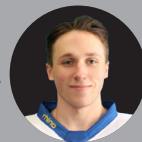
HARRY TEARY'S NOTABLE PLAYERS

Mac Howlett was a crucial part of the Leeds Knights' attack in the 2023/24 NIHL season, registering 73 points (35 goals, 38 assists) in 53 games. His ability to play both center and wing adds flexibility to the Knights' lineup. Howlett's playoff performance was also notable, contributing 15 points (6 goals, 9 assists) in 8 games. His offensive output and versatility make him an indispensable asset for Leeds.



Kieran Brown once again demonstrated why he's one of the top players in the NIHL during the 2023/24 season, leading the Leeds Knights with an astounding 122 points (61 goals, 61 assists) in 52 games. As team captain, Brown's leadership on and off the ice is invaluable, guiding the Knights through a successful campaign. His playoff numbers were equally impressive, with 14 points (7 goals, 7 assists) in 8 games.

In his first full season with the Leeds Knights, Bowdyn Neely established himself as a solid two-way defenseman. During the 2023/24 NIHL season, he contributed 35 points (5 goals, 30 assists) in 54 games, demonstrating his ability to support the offense while maintaining his defensive responsibilities. Neely also added 6 assists in 8 playoff games, showcasing his consistency in high-pressure situations. His steady presence on the blue line will be crucial for the Knights in the upcoming season.
