



PLAYER PROFILE



James Griffin brought both experience and grit to the Milton Keynes Lightning in the 2023/24 NIHL season. In 42 games, Griffin tallied 20 points (11 goals, 9 assists), showing his ability to contribute offensively while being a physical presence on the ice, amassing 75 penalty minutes. Although he didn't score in the playofffs, Griffin's leadership and tenacity were invaluable during the season. His combination of scoring touch and defensive prowess makes him a crucial player for the Lightning.



Chris Jones continued to be a reliable offensive force for the Swindon Wildcats during the 2023/24 season, amassing 54 points (19 goals, 35 assists) in 54 games. As one of the team's alternate captains, Jones also played a vital role in the playoffs, where he added 3 points in 7 games. His leadership and consistent two-way play make him an indispensable part of the Wildcats' lineup as they head into the 2024/25 season.





Glenn Billing had a stellar 2023/24 season with the Swindon Wildcats, leading the team with 70 points (31 goals, 39 assists) in 54 games. Billing's vision and scoring touch were key to Swindon's offense, and he continued to deliver in the playoffs, adding 4 points in 7 games. His ability to create opportunities and finish plays makes him one of the top centers in the NIHL, and he will be a crucial player for the Wildcats moving forward.

Edward Bradley joined the Swindon Wildcats for the 2024/25 season after splitting the previous year between the Bristol Pitbulls and Berkshire Bees. In 2023/24, Bradley tallied 40 points (9 goals, 31 assists) over 47 games, showcasing his ability to contribute offensively from the blue line. Bradley's strong skating and puck-moving skills will be vital for Swindon as they look to strengthen their defensive corps this season.
